Suitable for larger vessels to 12M in deeper water.

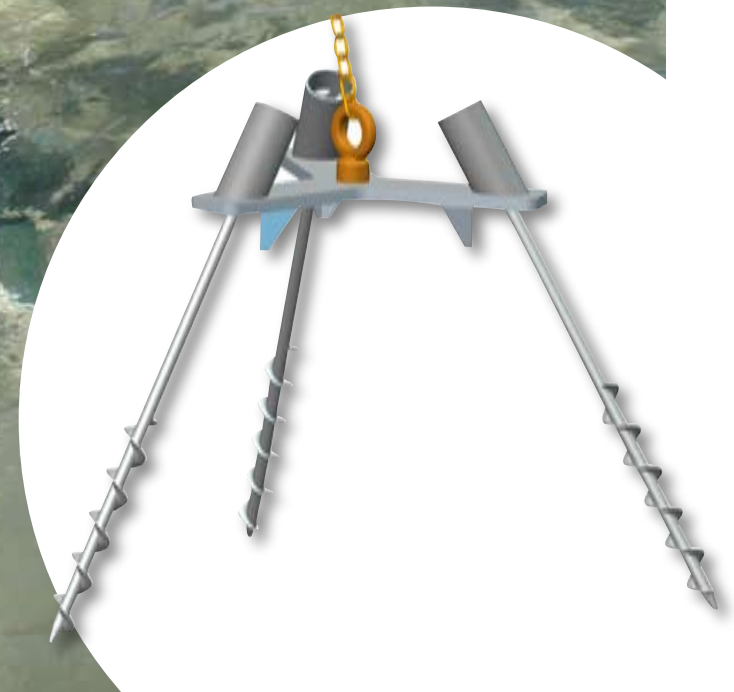
